B. Resolutions Transfers:

- b. Res 2019-02 transferring funds from the General Fund to the Length of Service Fund in the amount of \$5,200. *Moved by Director Strohmeyer, seconded by Director Myers, to approve Resolution 2019-02.*
- c. Res 2019-03 transferring funds from the General Fund to the Building Fund in the amount of \$23,000. <u>Moved by Director Myers, seconded by Director Strohmeyer, to approve Resolution 2019-03.</u>
- d. Res 2019-04 transferring funds from the General Fund to the Equipment Fund in the amount of \$ 20,000. <u>Moved by Director Porter, seconded by Director Myers, to approve Resolution 2019-04.</u>
- e. Res 201-05 transferring funds from the General Fund to the Personnel Fund in the amount of \$15,000. <u>Moved by Director Fery, seconded by Director Porter, to approve Resolution 2019-05.</u>

All motions passed unanimously.

- **C. Recruitment Update:** We have six people in Fire Academy; we have three in membership process, two scheduled for board of review and one that completed orientation. We are only holding one Academy per year; it takes about 5 months to complete. When we bring on new members before Academy, we get them involved at the District as much as possible until Academy starts.
- **D.** Gary Chrisman Retirement: Gary submitted his written resignation as of Dec. 31, 2018. Gary has been a volunteer for 37.5 years. We will be losing a valuable member and greatly appreciate all of his years of service. We will be recognizing him at our annual banquet.
- **E. Gates Fire District Report:** Chief reported all is going well. Their preventative maintenance on apparatus has been completed. The SCBAs they received from Sublimity are in service and everyone is trained on them. Doug Kintz will help Chief to teach them about disassembling and keeping their masks clean. Board meeting this next Thursday.
- **F. Strategic Plan Update:** AC Alley reported that the Health and Wellness group is meeting this week. We will also begin reviewing the other goals and present quarterly reports to the board on their progress.
- **G. Board Elections:** Both Directors up for election, Strohmeyer and Odenthal, have agreed to run for their positions again and will submit the required paperwork.
- **H.** Accounts Payable: <u>Moved by Director Myers, seconded by Director Porter, to pay the bills</u>. Motion carried unanimously.
