- A. Gates Fire District Contract: Stayton Fire has offered to work with Gates Fire District with interim assistance with Operational, Administrative and Bookkeeping services until they are able to get a replacement for Chief Swanson. Chief Swanson thanked the Board for their willingness to assist their district at this time. The Gates Fire Board is all in agreement and very welcoming to having Chief Carriger assist. <u>Moved by Director Porter, seconded by Director Myers, to approve the Fee for Service contract between Gates Fire and Stayton Fire.</u> Motion carried unanimously.
- **B.** Seismic Grant / Project Update: Everything is moving along well; Marion station is framed in and new roof is on, there will be a new ADA bathroom and kitchen. We are on budget. Marion station will postpone their Open House they usually have on National Night out until their station work is done. They started work here at Station 80 on the sprinklers right now, and then the contractors will start work on the seismic rehab. Mehama station footings have been poured and they are starting to put station back together. Elkhorn station should be done next week with final walk-through on June 20th. The contractors have done a good job cleaning up after their work.

- **D.** St 85 Elkhorn Plan Update: Chief, AC, Sherry Bensema, Taunie Alley and Scott Orr did a door-to-door campaign to all the residents of Elkhorn to inform them of the need for volunteers. The majority of the population is not physically able to do the job. The younger population does not have the time with long commutes, long workweeks. Chief and AC will now decide the best plan of action for that station.
