FEMA Disaster Assistance | Applications are due no later than Nov. 16. Apply online at: www.DisasterAssistance.gov. FEMA representatives are available to help you with your application at the External Outreach Center from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily. The center is located at the Stayton Community Center at 400 W Virginia Street.

Debris Removal | The EPA will remove household hazardous waste from your property free of charge. Right of Entry form is due by October 16 and is available online at: www.MCWildfireRecovery.net. Call (503) 365-3140 for further assistance.
